**Helping Students
Succeed By
Promoting
Adaptive Beliefs:
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& How to Impact
Them**

This talk will provide an overview of the research on learning mindsets and how subtle differences in the framing of praise, critical feedback, and responses to failure can support children in developing adaptive mindsets and becoming engaged learners who can rebound more quickly from adversity.

Students' mindsets—whether they believe intelligence can be developed, whether they feel like they belong at school, and whether they see the value of their coursework—affects their motivation and resilience. When students are supported in developing adaptive beliefs, they are more willing to take on challenging work, more open to critical feedback, more likely to persist through setbacks, and more resilient to difficult life experiences.
